

PARAGLIDING ACCESS AND PRICING

The Ranch is happy to be able to welcome and host paragliders in the pursuit of their non-consumptive and ecologically mindful sport. Their activity offers us at The High Lonesome Ranch the opportunity to share what we're doing in our enthusiasm for The Land with like-minded people through flying and camping.

The landscape offers amazing flying opportunities for early morning thermal, record setting cross country flights, and evening glassoffs. The site requires a high degree of technical knowledge and experience. Pilots must have a current USHPA license. P3 pilots and higher must have either flown at the Fly in or received a site intro from an approved site Mentor (Brian Greeson or Lukas Hill). P2 and lower pilots are welcome with licensed instructors present.

FOR GENERAL ACCESS:

- Pilots must make a reservation a minimum of 48 hours in advance of when they intend to arrive.
- Please call the office +1 (970) 283-9420 or email reservations@thehighlonesomeranch.com.
- Upon arrival, pilots need to check in at The Mercantile at HQ and provide proof of USHPA License and Driver's License if they intend to drive up the Cow Mountain Road, as well as license plate number for their vehicle and camper.
- They will need to complete <u>the High Lonesome Ranch Liability Waiver</u> before or immediately on arrival.
- Shuttles are \$25 per person per trip with a minimum of 3 people and a maximum relative to the number of seatbelts in the vehicle driven.
- Pool access is \$5 per person

Dry camping at The Landing Area: \$25 per tent, rv, vehicle per night. Includes use of restrooms and showers at HQ. Please practice <u>Leave No Trace Camping</u>. Campfires are only allowed in designated firepit for communal use. This includes access to the hiking trail up to launch and the access code to the gates up Cow Mountain.

Day Access: \$20 per pilot

This includes access to the hiking trail up to launch and the access code to the gates up Cow Mountain.

MEMBERSHIP: Monthly or Annually

MONTHLY:

- \$50 per pilot per month
- Includes code access to Cow Mountain Road, day parking at the Landing area, hiking access to launch.
- Includes 2 weekends of dry camping at Landing Area, additional nights of camping are \$15 per tent, rv, vehicle.
- 10% off Guest House lodging, purchases in the Mercantile, and additional pool passes.
- Includes pool access for pilot

Annually:

- \$400 per pilot
- 10% on Guest House lodging and on purchases in the Mercantile.
- Includes pool pass for pilot and one guest.
- Includes 7 weekends of dry camping at Landing Area, additional nights of camping are \$15 per tent, rv, vehicle.
- Includes code access to Cow Mountain Road, day parking at the Landing area, hiking access to launch.
- 1 shuttle to launch

RETREATS AND WORKSHOPS: Instructor and Organizer pricing

- Dry Camping at the Landing Area \$60 per participant for 2 nights camping, \$20 for non-flying guests, volunteers, and instructors for 2 nights. Additional consecutive nights are \$15 each tent, camper, rv. Please practice Leave No Trace Camping. Campfires are only allowed in designated firepit for communal use. This includes access to the hiking trail up to launch and the access code to the gates up Cow Mountain.
- Access to HQ bathrooms, showers, pool
- Use of one HLR radio to keep communications open to HQ if needed
- Shuttles are \$15 per person per trip with a minimum of 3 people and maximum passengers per vehicle relative to the number of seatbelts in the vehicle driven
- 10% off Guest House lodging and purchases in the Mercantile during the event.

TANDEM:

- Available through High Desert Paragliding
- Morning Launches from Cow Ridge
- Choose the basic Sightseeing Flight or add the gopro video option for an additional cost but memories you can share with friends and family
- Paragliding requires the right weather to do and for safety. If weather causes you not to fly, our instructors will do their best to take you out on a different day during your stay. We do not refund due to weather-related cancellations.
- The safety of our guests and guides is paramount, our instructors have the final say in whether you fly that day, the duration of your flight, and where you land.
- Additional flight time is contingent on conditions and will be discussed before take-off with final approval in-flight
